

## Thematic Poster Sessions

Thematic poster sessions will consist of two key parts: (1) poster presentations of abstracts focused around a central theme followed by a (2) moderated discussion. These sessions are designed to engage the authors and members of the audience in a discussion that ties together ideas from multiple posters in the session.

- Each session will consist of 20 minutes of poster viewing (2 minutes each), followed by 60 minutes of moderated discussion.
- Authors will present their posters on a one-on-one or small group basis.
- Sessions will be held at the Nashville Music City Center, TN and may be eligible for continuing education credits.

## Eligibility Criteria

- The poster author must attend NACFC 2019 and present the abstract.
- Abstracts must be submitted in accordance with the NACFC 2019 Rules and Instructions for Submitting Abstracts which can be found at <https://www.nacfcconference.org/Submissions/Abstracts/>.
- Abstracts must be accepted for presentation at NACFC 2019.
- An abstract chosen for oral presentation in a workshop session during NACFC 2019 is **NOT eligible** to be selected for presentation in a thematic poster session.

## Selection Process

- Moderators select 10 posters focused around a central theme from NACFC 2019 accepted abstracts by **July 29** deadline.
- Posters for thematic poster sessions will be chosen after the workshop moderators have selected abstracts for oral presentation in workshop sessions.

## Author Notification

- Presenters of abstracts selected for thematic poster sessions will be notified by **Aug 13**.
- Author notifications will contain detailed instructions regarding session presentation.

## Financial Considerations

- Presenters outside of North America will qualify for registration fee waiver.
- If the presenter registers for NACFC 2019 and submits payment prior to becoming eligible for this registration fee waiver, a refund for their registration fee payment will be issued.
