All NACFC attendees, including speakers and session leaders, must make their own travel arrangements.

Air Travel:

Denver International Airport – DEN

- Non-stop service for more than (160) domestic destinations
- Non-stop service for (20) international destinations including Mexico, Germany and the United Kingdom.
- Approximately 40 minutes from Downtown Denver

Ground Transportation:

Taxi:

40 minutes and \$55 taxi cab from airport to the Colorado Convention Center, Hyatt Regency, and other official NACFC hotels.

Airport Rail Line:

This new light rail line runs to and from the Airport to Union Station in downtown. Just about a 37-minute ride - the train conveniently leaves every 15 minutes during peak hours, for a \$9.00 flat rate.

16th Street MallRide:

Called the MallRide, this free hybrid vehicle scoots up and down the 16-block retail core of downtown Denver, also home to hotels and restaurants. Hop on at any intersection on 16th St. between Civic Center Station at Broadway

Union Station:

New downtown transit center located at 1700 Wewatta Street in Denver. Visit <http://www.rtd-denver.com/UnionStation.shtml> for more information!

Light Rail:

The trendy train travels on 34.8 miles of tracks from the 'burbs to the city, making stops at 36 stations along the way. Visit [Regional Transportation District \(RTD\)](#) for information on fares, zones, schedules, special services and much more.

Uber/Lyft:

Services from [Uber](#) and [Lyft](#) are available in The Mile High City. If you're a new Lyft user, enjoy up to \$20 in ride credits. Simply download the Lyft mobile app, enter the VISITDEN code under the app's "Promos" section, request a ride and you're on your way.
